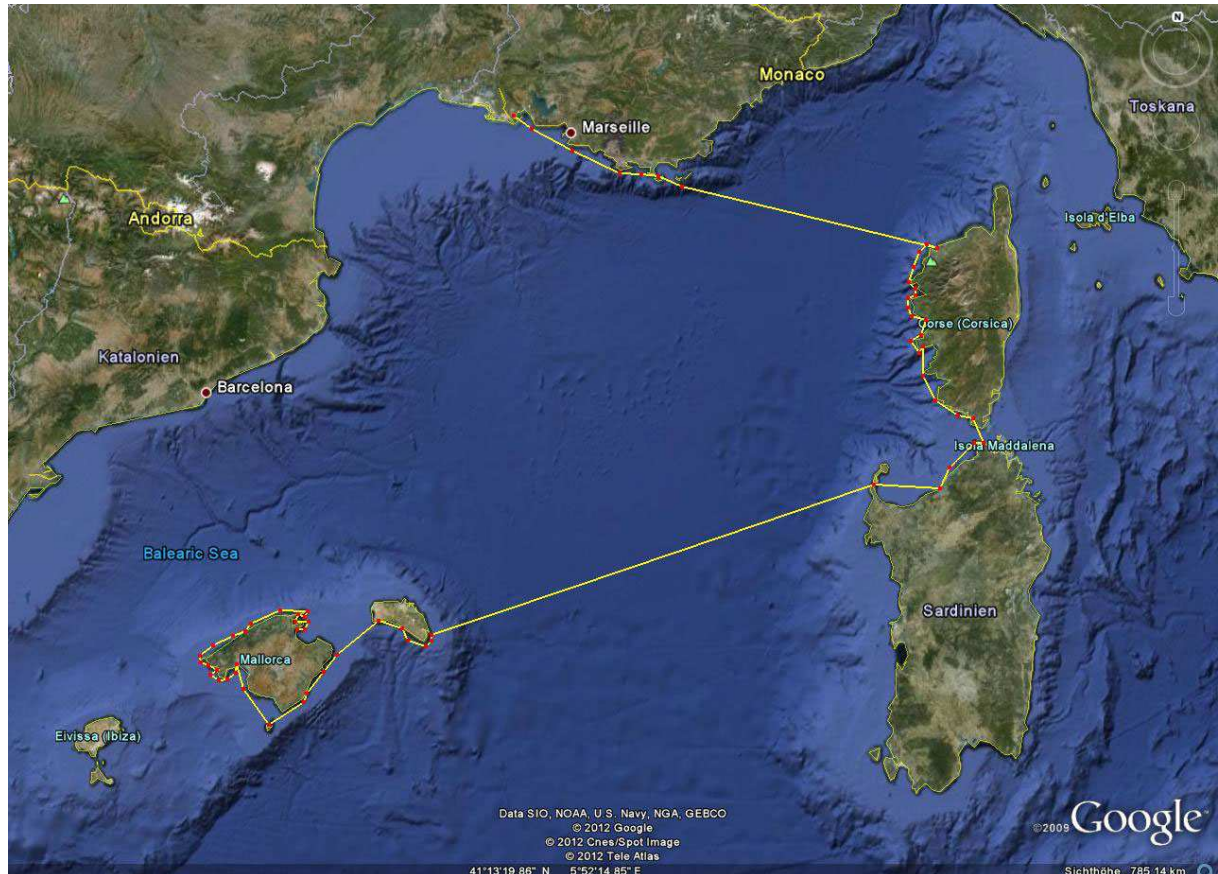


Sailing from Marseille, France to Alcudia, Mallorca September 2012

This time we could manage to take a time out of four weeks from end of August to end of September.

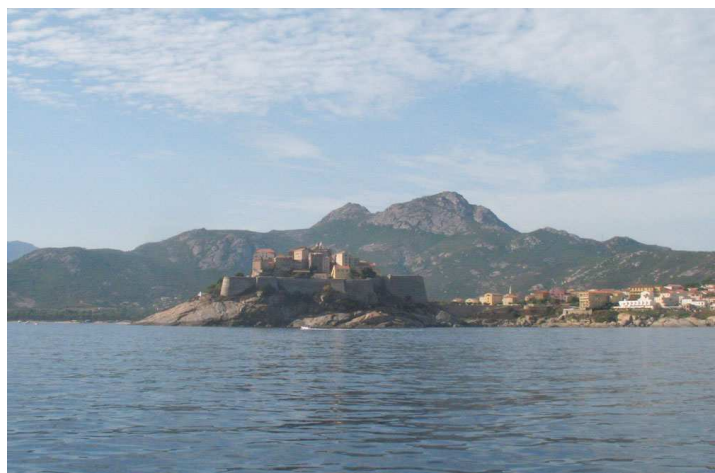
Following the general intention to leave the Med for the Atlantic, we took a first step to the south, but not without visiting Corsica and Sardinina.



In total we made 811nm, due to a lack of wind with many engine hours. The two major leaps were from Ile de Porquerolles, Côte d'Azur to Calvi, Corsica (120nm) and from the Fornelli-Passage, Sardinina to Mahón, Menorca (200nm).

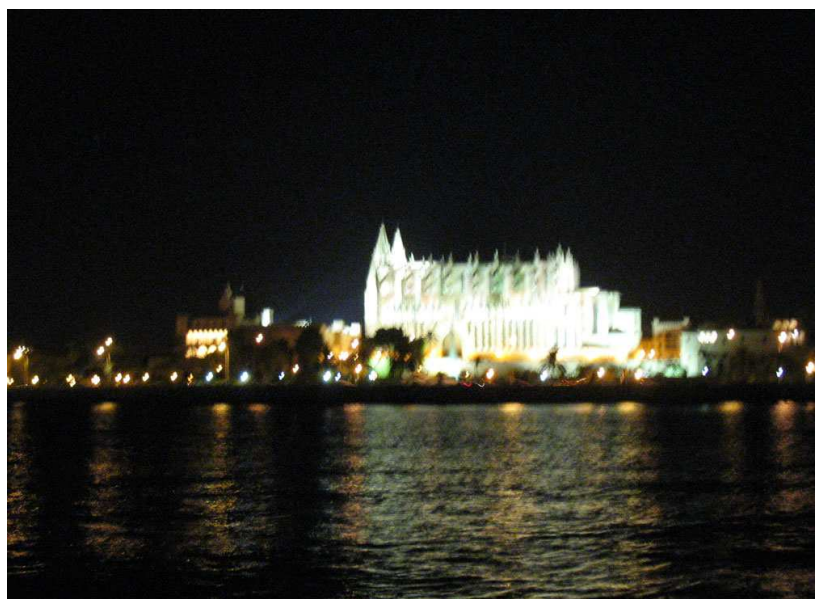
